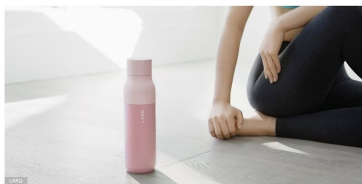


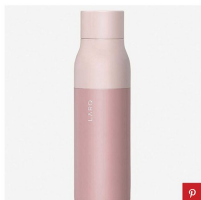

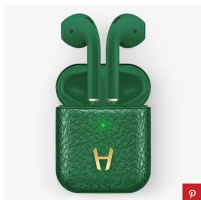

It intelligently activates every two hours, keeping your contents automatically sanitised, while the double-insulated construction keeps your water cold for 24 hours - or hot for 12 - in a travel-friendly size. One charge via USB lasts up to a month with no replacement filters or batteries needed.
